Dates: Two Saturdays a Month from September 24th-November 19th



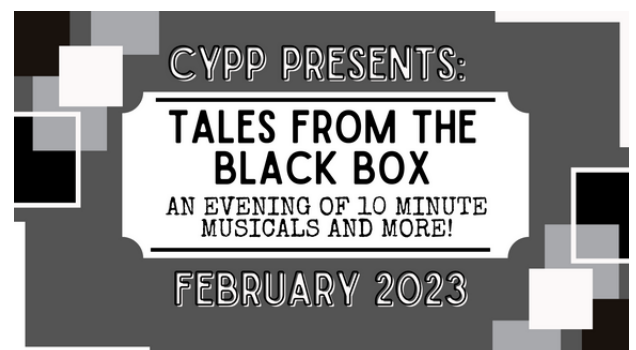
